Call for Applications – Program Manager

The Friedrich-Ebert-Stiftung (FES) is searching for a Program Manager at the FES Office in the Palestinian Territories located in East Jerusalem.

The FES is a non-profit organization working with long-term partners on projects of a political nature. As a German political foundation our work is based on social democratic values. With our worldwide network of offices - 11 of them in the MENA region, including Israel - FES pursues pluralism and democracy and is supporting economic and social development. Equal rights for women and the promotion of broad human rights are of special significance.

Among our priorities in the Palestinian Territories is the development of political institutions and parties that can support a future democratic Palestinian state. The preconditions for this include an active civil society, economic development and social security as well as the development of peaceful strategies. FES lends its support to political and civic decision makers in developing a Palestinian bargaining position in the international arena. To this end, FES cooperates with Palestinian partner institutions such as NGOs, think tanks, academic institutions and political parties.

Tasks in the position mentioned above include assisting in conceptual and organizational supervision of FES projects in the Palestinian Territories by keeping close contact with our partners in the West Bank and East Jerusalem as well as contributing to political analysis, research and information programs of the FES Office in the Palestinian Territories.

- holding an upper level university degree in International Law, Peace and Conflict Studies, Social Sciences or other academic fields related to the work of FES in the Palestinian Territories
- with prior work experience in a related field (please provide references)
- being familiar with project management and evaluation methodology in international development cooperation
- being familiar with political parties and social democracy
- with excellent proficiency in Arabic and English, ideally in Hebrew and /or German as well
- with strong organizational and communication skills
- being stress resistant and enjoying work in a diverse team
